### Meetings

- Once per half term
- 1 hour meetings
- Role for prefects and Sixth Form SLT

### Recruitment

- **Application process**
- **Chosen by prefects and HASF SLT acting as recruitment panel**

### Roles

- Positions of 'Ministers of...' that provide Student Leadership opportunities and a chance to work with the local community.
- Consultation about **key matters** of the academy.
- Seeking advice from students on new initiatives.
- 'Inviting comment on ways of solving problems that are affecting the teacher's right to teach and the student's right to learn'.
- Giving evaluative comments on recent developments in the academy.
- Informing school decision making.
- Lead year meetings with other **CC's** in order to feedback points raised from meetings.
- Co-ordination of other aspects of student voice e.g. departmental surveys
- Liaison with other school councils and local council.

### Meetings

- 1 meeting per half term.
- Meeting during a tutorial slot.
- Agenda set and chaired by Year Group Parliament Members.

### Recruitment

- Form application and elections.

### Roles

- To gather views from forms they represent.
- To feedback to forms the outcomes of meetings from the Council & Parliament.

### The Electorate

The student body – in set form times (Surgeries). Listen to feedback from the Council Members and raise debate for the next meeting.
